Curtiss-Wright Field / (Original) Wiley Post Airport Oklahoma City, OK

35.57 North / 97.32 West (Northwest of Downtown Oklahoma City, OK)

1932
"I remember one incident (I think I was still in grade school), when a bootlegger overboarded his plane and attempted to take off to the south after dark. He got off the ground, but failed to clear the line of trees on the south side of Britton Road. Word spread throughout the neighborhood like wild fire & all the kids rushed to the scene (bear in mind that Oklahoma still had prohibition until 1933). Everything that wasn't broken was cleaned out before the police arrived. I don't know what became of the bootlegger." Jim Shaw

1944
The April 1944 U.S. Army/Navy Directory of Airfields described Wiley Post Airport as having a 3,000' unpaved runway, and indicated that Navy flight operations were conducted from the field. "Ken Umetsu"

1950
"I can imagine that what led to the closure was the nearby Tulsa Airfield, built in 1942 as an auxiliary to the Army's Will Rogers Field located at the Oklahoma City Municipal Airport. The field was subsequently developed into a residential neighborhood." Jim Shaw

1955
"The hanger that Curtiss-Wright Company had built at the field in 1928 was, in 1960, converted into first a shopping center & then a church." Jim Shaw

Original name of this airport was Curtiss-Wright Field. It is located north of Oklahoma City, near the Bluff Creek area (later known as Lake Hefner). Curtiss-Wright Field was demolished in 1928.


